FREEDOM'S VISION = GOD'S PLAN

There is a tangible sense in our church family that we are in this together so that whatever God has for us, we're ready. This spirit of unity is vital as we move forward and you can feel the momentum building as we do this together.

MAXIMIZE, INCREASE, RENOVATE & UPGRADE

Since the spring of 2013, we have:

- Renovated the FCC upstairs into a lounge, updated the kitchen & bathroom and the two keyboard studios for the School of Music.
- Renovated the FCC main floor into meeting spaces, updated the kitchen & bathroom and repaired the mudroom.
- Created a Youth Wing from the FCC's building addition.
- Updated the sanctuary lighting.
- Installed a sound curtain and new flooring and added a sound system to the Fellowship Hall.
- Paved the driveway and updated the entrance and kitchen sidewalk concrete.
- Renovated the main church kitchen.



The new developments Mattamy & RBJ Schlegel) will bring thousands of new neighbours to our doorstep.

The Freedom Community Centre has served over 250 KW families on a regular basis.

If 10 new families joined Freedom, we would be at capacity on Sunday morning.

The Pavilion: Why and What

THE NEXT RIGHT INVESTMENT

We have always known that the grey shed needed an overhaul. Couple that with the dream to have an outdoor space to facilitate CONNECTING and IMPACTING on our property and for the past two years we've been working on the pavilion project. This project is the most cost-effective way to add new square footage and ministry value.

WHAT THE PAVILION WILL DO


- Replace our dilapidated shed with clean, dry, safe storage.
- Give us outdoor seating space for 200+ people (more than our Fellowship Hall!).
- Facilitate all outdoor activities for camp, children and youth ministries.
- Welcome the community to connect with us and one another.
- Make accessible washrooms available from the sports fields.
- Add basketball courts to our field offerings.
- Add potential for "rustic" indoor space for small groups to meet.

WHAT THE PAVILION COULD DO

- Facilitate outdoor services & picnics.
- Expand FCC programs and partnerships with Williamsburg & Huron Community Associations.
- Become a place where our church family gets to know our neighbours and builds relationships.
- Be available to host our neighbours in new ways that help us to CONNECT and IMPACT like... summer drop-in programs, parent groups, or community building activities.
- Support and facilitate expanded youth and children's ministries at Freedom.

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THIS INVESTMENT?

- 2500 square feet of new square footage with:
 - two accessible washrooms
 - in-floor heating
 - concession window
 - kitchenette
 - storage shelves and bins
 - indoor space to work and meet
- 2500 square feet of pavilion space with:
 - picnic table seating for 120+
- paved basketball court with permanent basketball net

WHO CAN GIVE TO THIS PROJECT?

Members, adherents, attendees and neighbours of Freedom Church and its various ministries... anyone with an interest in this ministry.

WHAT IS THE TIMELINE FOR THE PLEDGES AND PROJECT?

We had all planning and permitting complete by November 2021.

Construction began in December 2021 and will take about six months to complete. All funds need to be raised by mid-2022.

WILL WE BE RECEIPTED FOR OUR GIVING TO THIS PROJECT?

Yes. As with all offering revenues, all giving will be receipted in full at the end of each calendar year.

IF I'M CURRENTLY SEEKING TO BRING MY REGULAR GIVING TO THE TITHE LEVEL, WHAT SHOULD I DO ABOUT A PLEDGE?

Freedom Church is supported through the regular giving of tithes, offerings and missions dollars. Pledges for Welcome to Our House are over and above that level of giving. If you are still working on establishing your basic level of giving, do what you can because every dollar makes a difference.
